As we share our lives of faith together let us give thanks to God for the incredible graces our parish receives through your faithfulness to the Gospel of Jesus and the teachings of the Church.

It is important to note once again that it is through your generous contributions to the Sunday Offering that we are able to provide our ministries. Your support over the past year has provided an operating income of \$1,397,474!

Even as our Sunday Offerings have, for the first time, dropped below our budgeted goal, we were able to use *Other Income* to offset our operating deficit which provided \$10,039 for parish reserves. Our parish staff members have been good stewards as they carefully watched their budgets.

Your discipleship, prayers and involvement in parish ministries and activities are important parts of our Annual Report. Money is not our only resource. Rather, the greatest resources we have are our parishioners who actively share their lives in the parish. This is indicated in this Report.


As good stewards of God's gifts to us, we have drafted our parish budget with increased expenses for July 1, 2011 - June 30, 2012.

- **The budget is \$ 1,643,500.**
- **To meet our budget, the weekly Sunday Collection goal will remain at \$ 22,400.**

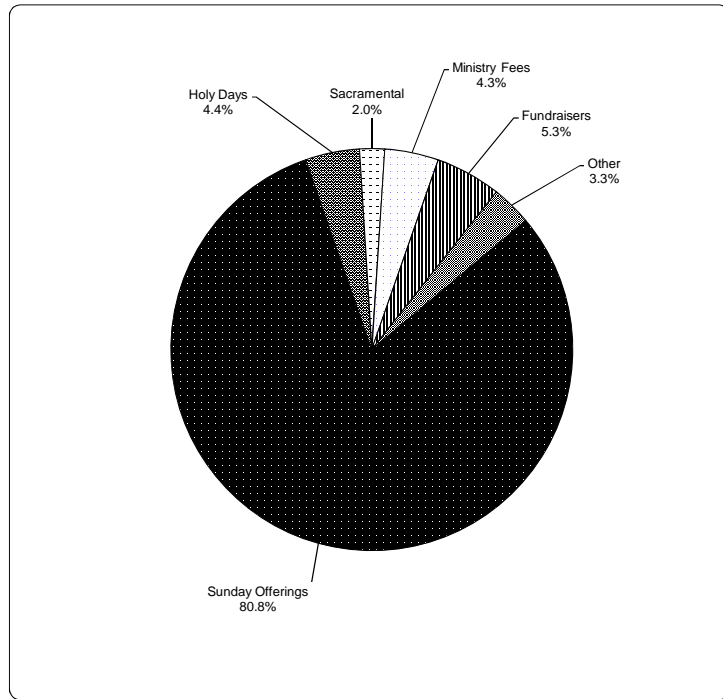
